

Container Centralen Opens New Depot in Greece



January 2010, Container Centralen (CC) opened a new depot in Athens, Greece. The opening of the depot brings new logistic opportunities to companies who want to export to Greece. The new CC depot in Athens accommodates the needs of Dutch and Italian exporters of plants in particular, as they needed a fixed location for return of CC Containers in Athens.

Faster return of CC Containers

The new depot in Greece makes faster return of CC Containers possible for all parties in the horticultural supply chain. Via the 'CC Transfer Service', CC

Containers are simply returned to the new depot in Athens, and a corresponding number of CC Containers can be picked up at another CC depot of the user's choice. As the users no longer have to wait for trucks returning from Greece, CC Containers are available for use without delay. Exporters are therefore able to use the same CC Containers for more deliveries, reducing the need for extra CC Containers. Furthermore, all CC Containers handed out from the CC depots have been checked, which ensures always functioning quality containers.

Registration Provides Balance Overview

CC Containers handed in at the Greek depot are registered as usual. This ensures a clear overview for all parties over the outstanding balances of CC Containers.

The depot in Greece is open five days a week for returns of CC Containers. Furthermore, the new depot also offers exchange of damaged equipment and rental of CC Containers.

The depot is located in Aspropyrgos, an Athens suburb, located at the Attiki Odos highway (A6/E84).
